Profile

Annai Veilankanni's Educational and Cultural Society was founded by Dr. S. Devaraj, in the year 1988, and has progressed steadily in its pursuit of excellence. The Society has been running schools in Saidapet and Vandalur for the past 32 years. The Management started Annai Veilankanni's College of Arts and Science in the year 2000. The college was approved by the Government of Tamil Nadu by its order No. 296, dated 10-07-2000 and the affiliation was granted by the University of Madras, the college was accredited by NAAC in September 2014.

The college aims to provide total quality education with emphasis on character development through a multi-textured approach towards honing generic skills, which lie dormant in every student. The strength of the college is its dedicated team of staff who are highly qualified and motivated. The excellent infrastructure of the college, a large spacious four-storey building with bright and airy classrooms facilitates effective teaching and learning.

The college is located one km from Saidapet Railway Station Et Bus Stand (West Side) and very near to West Saidapet Bus stand. The college encompasses more than 2500 students receiving holistic education every year. Semester pattern is followed for all the courses. NSS, YRC & RRC Units

Students of NSS are moulded into civic-minded citizens always ready to shoulder responsibilities in the society. Members of NSS are involved in community out-reach programmes, campaigns on health and hygiene, blood donation, drug abuse, etc. The NSS volunteers also teach children in Chennai schools. Annual Special Camp is also organised by NSS. Blood donation camps are conducted by YRC and RRC every year in collaboration with I RCS. Awareness programme on cancer, organ donation, helmet rally and green kalam are organized every year.

Our NSS unit was awarded the First Prize at the university level for the year 2016-17.

Achievements

We have produced 87 UNIVERSITY RANKS and many students have secured CENTUM in subjects like Accountancy, Mathematics, Statistics and Income Tax.

Employability Skills Development Programme

Soft Skills Training, Personality Development and Pre-Placement training are provided for the students. Communication Skills, Life Skills and Personality Grooming are imparted in collaboration with "ICT Academy & Spell Bee". Government approved certificate courses like Tally, Photoshop, Prathmic-Hindi are conducted. Hindi and French are taught. Value-added Certified Courses are offered in Yoga & Aerobics, Beautician Course, Soft Skills Development and Fine Arts. Training are provided for Bank Exams and Group I and II Exams.









Co-Curricular Activities

The college blends academic inputs with co-curricular activities. The hidden talents of the students are brought out through cultural events. ASTRAL is an Inter Collegiate Cultural Fest hosted every year in the college. Many city colleges participate in the Cultural Fest and explore the stars within themselves through the display of their amazing talents. The students are encouraged to participate in inter-collegiate, state and national level competitions. Inter-departmental competitions, AVC Fest is also conducted in the college every year. Each department organises its own club activities to bring out their curriculum potential of students

Celebrations

Important national and religious days are celebrated every year. Christmas is celebrated joyfully every year. Pongal is celebrated in a grand manner to uphold the tradition and cultural heritage of Tamil Nadu. Sports Day, College Day and Graduation day are celebrated where deserving meritorious students are honoured with medals and prizes. AVC National conference is an added event in the agenda of the college. International conference was organized by the Department of Tamil and National Seminars was organised by the Departments of Computer Science, Computer Applications, Information Systems Management, Commerce and Business Administration. Every year National Seminars are organised by various departments.

Placement & Training

The Placement & Training Cell ensures building up strong industry interface and enhancing industry interaction. This cell functions in an effective manner, providing suitable jobs for our students. It has good rapport with leading companies, banking and corporate sectors. Training is given regularly in interview skills, reasoning, quantitative aptitude and group discussion.

A mega job fair is organized every year on the campus for our students. It also involves students from various colleges in and around Chennai. The annual job fair attracts about 2500 students every year and nearly 600 students are offered jobs. The job fair 2019 was organized on 21st Feb 2020. All students of our college participated and 250 were recruited by various companies. The companies participated in the job fair included - MPower Young India, CSS Corp, Mercury Solutions, Alcance Technologies, Ripe academy, Rupeezone, Catalist, Apollo Medskills, Vertex, ICICI Prudential, Genie Consultants, Heera Manpower, Mahindra Pride, Ma Foi Academy, ICICI Acadey and UTL.

With whole hearted social commitment, we sculpt the future of our students. Need - based training and career guidance programmes are organized in collaboration with Mafoi Academy and Ripe Academy to facilitate campus selection.

Examination & Unit Tests

Semester pattern is followed. Each year has 2 semesters with University Examinations in November and April. There are 6 semesters for U.G. course and 4 semesters for P.G. course. Unit tests are

conducted regularly for Continuous Internal Assessment.

Transport Facility

The college provides bus facility for the students to commute from different parts of the city and from Saidapet railway station and bus stand at a nominal amount.

University Fee

The fee prescribed by the University for registration and examinations will be collected from each student separately and sent to the University of Madras as per the University norms.

Admission

How to apply

- 1. Application for admission to a course should be made in the prescribed application form which is available along with the prospectus. Incomplete application forms will not be accepted.
- 2. Each application should be accompanied by photo copies of the following:
 - a) Higher Secondary Mark Sheet or its equivalent
 - b) Transfer Certificate from the school last attended
 - c) Conduct Certificate from the Principal of the school last attended
 - d) Community Certificate issued by a competent authority in the case of BC, MBC, SC, ST.
 - e) Three recent passport size and three stamp size photographs
 - f) Eligibility Certificate from the University of Madras (for students from outside Tamilnadu)
 - g) Foreign students must also submit:
 - a) No Objection Certificate of HRD, Government of India
 - b) Eligibility Certificate from the University of Madras
 - c) Valid student visa
 - h) Sport certificates) District level and above)
- 3. (i) Candidates who satisfy the eligibility criteria will receive interview cards which are valid only until the date specified. The receipt of interview cards, does not guarantee admission. At the time of interview all the original certificates of the candidates will be scrutinized. Selected candidates will be issued admission cards only after payment of fee.
 - (ii) The selected candidates will have to deposit all the original certificates to the College and they will not be returned till the completion of the course.
 - (iii) Fee once paid will not be refunded. Students dismissed on disciplinary grounds will have to forfeit the entire fee.

Withdrawals

A student once enrolled for a course is expected to complete the same. If a student wishes to leave the college at any time before the completion of the course, she will have to pay the entire fee for the whole course.
